VINEYARD | WINE

Vinařství Ludwig was founded in 1992 by Ludvík Šlancar whose family has more than 100 years of winemaking experience. The winery produces more than 10 product lines, truly something for everyone, including specialty “late harvest” and “selection of grapes” bottles. Ludwig wines have won multiple Platinum, Double Gold, Gold, Silver and Bronze at global competitions including San Francisco, Finger Lakes, Vienna, and Prague. The winery is located in the sub-region Velke Pavlovice | Moravia.

The winemaker is Ludvík Šlancar.

This award-winning wine is 100% Neuburger grape, a white variety similar to Grüner Veltliner and Riesling. It lends itself well to sweet and dessert wines, aided by botrytis, a helpful mold which accents the honey tones in the wines. Gold Medal winner Berlin 2018.
