The Lahofer Winery was established in 2003 and rebranded to its current name in 2006. They are one of the largest wineries in the Czech Republic with more than 400 hectares of vines under production. Of these, approximate 100 hectares are farmed organically. They produce a number of product lines with a focus on traditional Czech grape varieties. The winery is located in the sub-region Znojmo | Moravia.

The winemaker is Michal Eller.

This wine is 100% Müller Thurgau. Vintage is 2019. Müller Thurgau is a cross of Riesling and Madeleine Royale.
